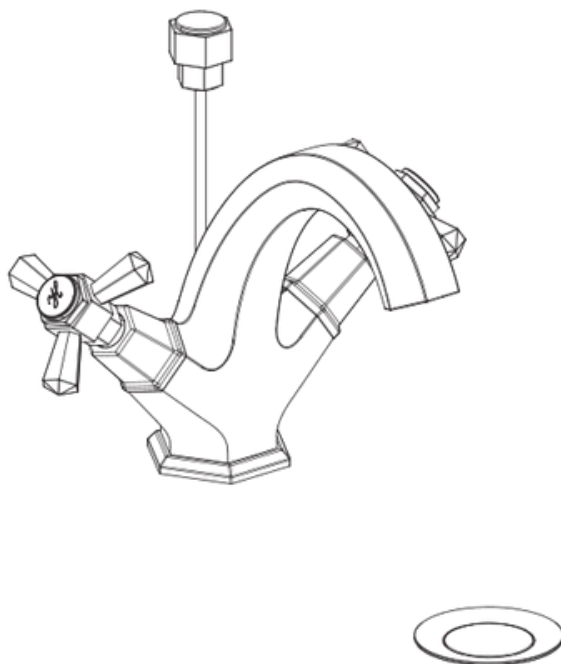

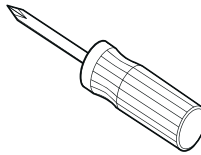
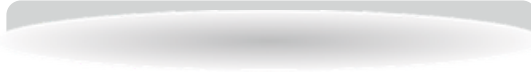


WARNING

Recommended water pressure: 7.25 - 43.5 psi

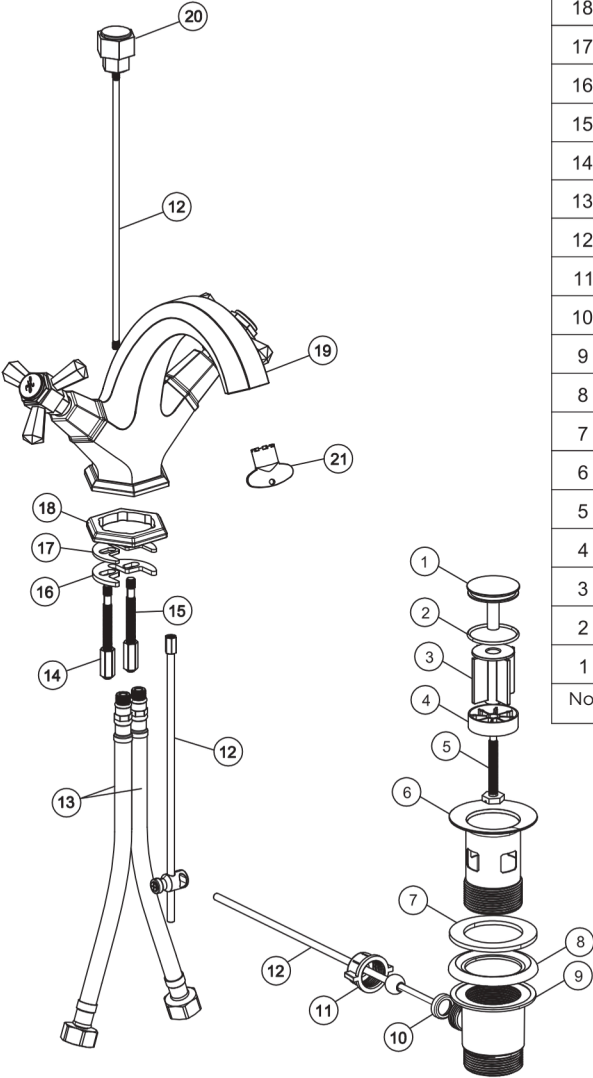

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

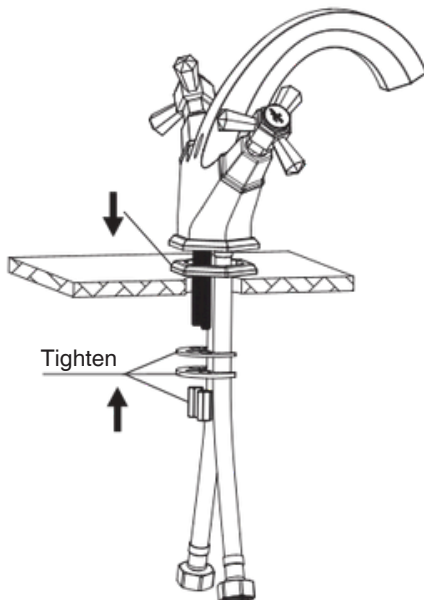

Fit the flexible hoses to the tap body, ensuring that you do not overtighten. Then install the fixing bolt into the screw hole of the tap body. Remove the fixing nut. Place the washer on the tap body.

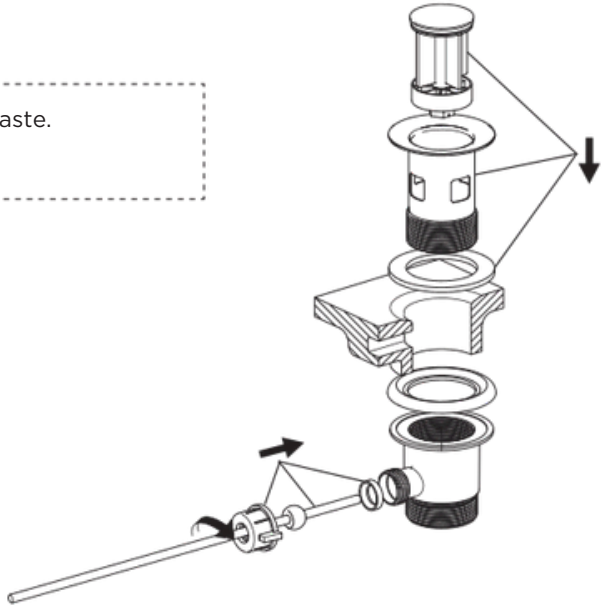
Secure the tap body to the basin using the rubber washer, metal washer and fixing nut.

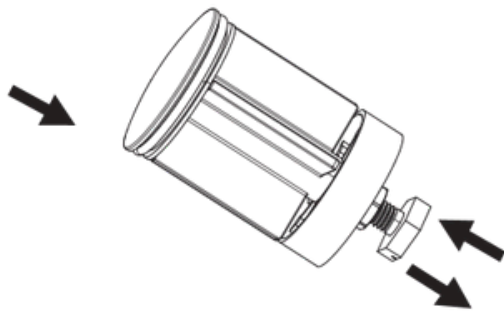
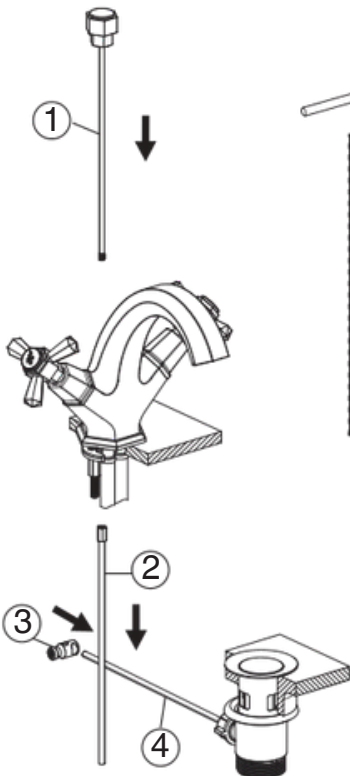
Install the basin waste.

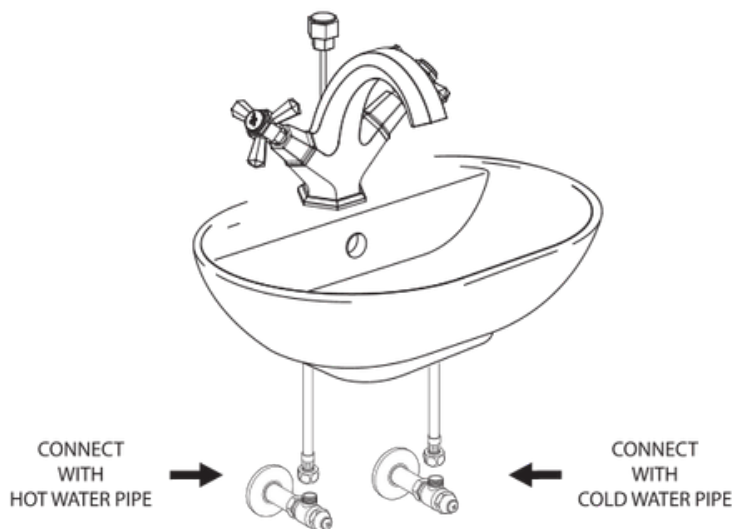

Install the lift rod assembly.

Insert the connection rod (2) into the connector (3), then insert the connector (3) into the rod (4). Pass the lift rod (1) through the tap body, connect the lift rod (1) to the connection rod (2) using the fixing nut. Tighten the screw on the connector (3). Adjust the screw on the waste plug to achieve the proper lift position. Check all joints and connections for leakage.





AFTER INSTALLATION

Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the off position. Turn on the drain and main water supply, and check for leaks. Repair as needed.

CARE & CLEANING

Your new tap is designed for years of trouble-free performance. Keep it looking new by cleaning it periodically with mild soap, rinse thoroughly with warm water and dry with a clean, soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool or harsh chemicals, as these will dull the finish. Failure to follow these instructions may void your warranty.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

If you've followed the instructions carefully and your tap still does not work properly, take these corrective steps.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Insufficient water	- Aerator clogged	- Clean aerator, replace if necessary
Mixer stiff	- Cartridge defective	- Replace cartridge
Mixer dripping	- Cartridge defective	- Replace cartridge
Water leaks below handle	- Cartridge defective	- Replace cartridge
	- O-ring/rings defective	- Replace O-ring/rings
Water leaks at the connection	- Loose connection	- Tighten connection
